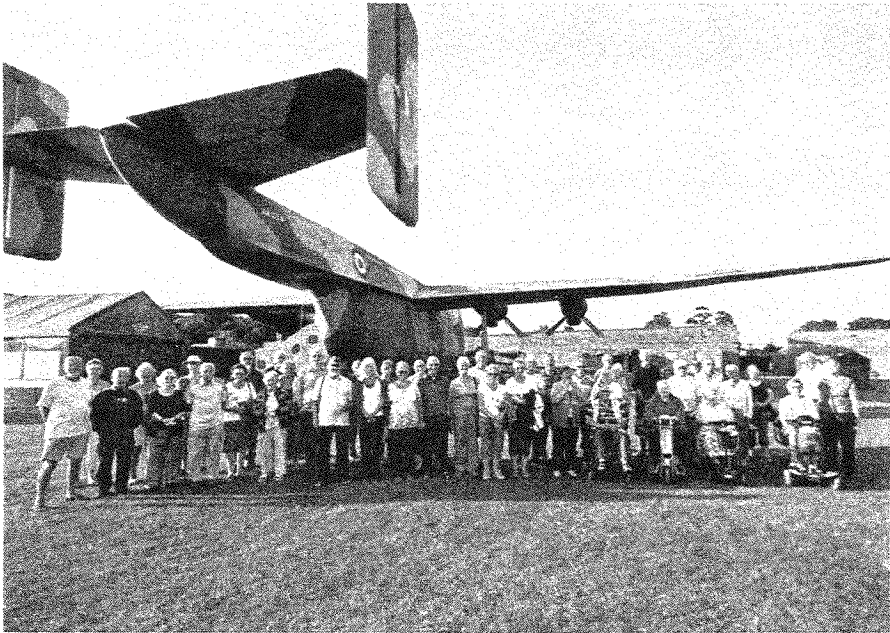

Repairs to Shower Trays and Sinks.

The finished shower tray on show with the before and after look was very neat indeed and was guaranteed.

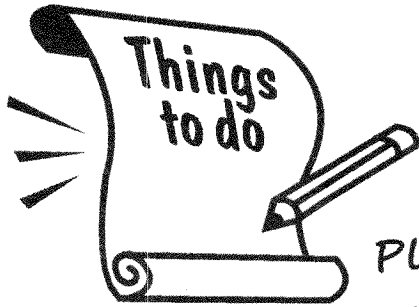
Recently I have heard members speaking about their shower tray cracking and leaking with the prospect of a costly repair by the physical removal and replacement of the said tray.

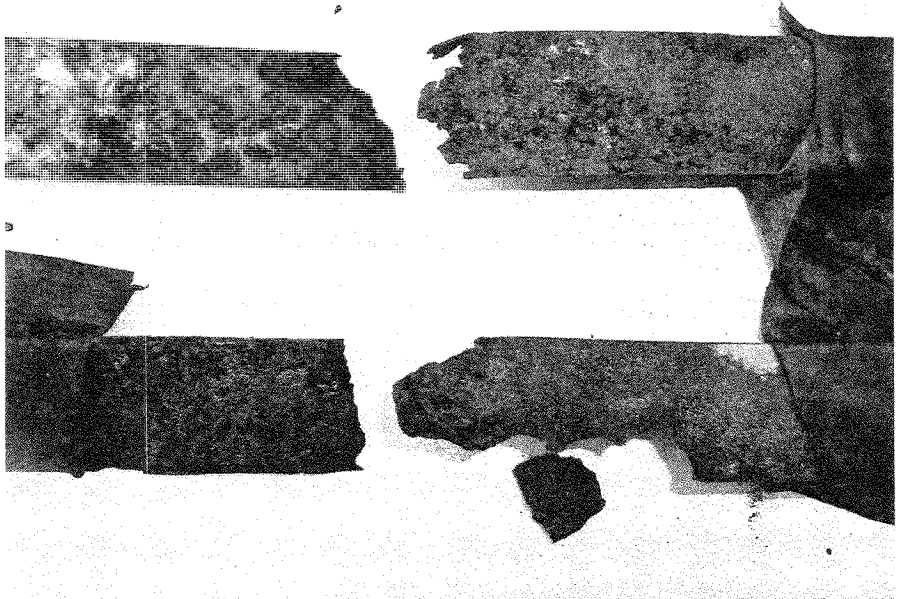

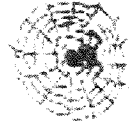
Who would have thought that so many people would mistake the included bodyboard for an ironing board?

Auto Sleepers 2013:

For members not able to attend the October NEC show – the following is a brief review of the main A~S changes for 2013:-

- There will be new A~S models on the Mercedes chassis – the Burford*; Burford Duo and the Winchcombe^ . For the Marquis range two will be marketed as the Wiltshire* and the Somerset^ .
- The Symbol will have a completely new layout, with a lower steel roof.
- Two new Broadway options on the LWB 3.5t Peugeot chassis – the FB & EL - will be available. The Cotswold will be effectively incorporated within the Broadway range.
- The Malvern is being incorporated within the Mercedes line, and the name will disappear.
- For VW chassis the Topaz will continue in production, whilst the Trident & Trooper will only be built to order. A~S will consider carrying out conversions on a second-hand vehicle (depending on age, condition etc) to Trident high-top or Trooper elevating roof.
- There are no plans to build any more Stratfords, but it may be revamped next year.
- All the other existing models will be receiving specification updates.

Mercedes Euro V Coolant issue: A member has reported that there is a possible problem with coolant loss on some Mercedes Euro V engines. There is, I understand, a housing gasket (connected' with the fuel filter) that may leak. Mercedes are aware and are replacing the complete housing. I suggest

that you keep an eye on your coolant level and contact your Mercedes dealer for further advice

Underfloor LPG Tank:-

Whilst my new LPG tank was being installed by Chris Wise (of Autogas 2000) he remarked that quite a few ASOC Club members had quizzed him at the recent Malvern Show regarding safety of tank straps. Following discussion he has kindly offered a free inspection of LPG tank straps for Club members. Please contact Chris Wise, personally, and state that you are an ASOC Club member and wish to take advantage of the offer.

Three members have already reported back that their LPG straps needed replacing. It is recommended that the tank fixing should be inspected annually and the tank itself be pressure tested/cleaned after 10 years.

Cleaning sanitary items: Following a request for clarification on cleaning such items as toilets, basins, shower trays etc., I can confirm that advice is given in the van's handbook. However, as a reminder, the general advice is - not to use any household cleaners. Also its best to avoid use of antiseptic mouthwash as there have been reports that the fluid can damage some sinks.
